Here are some simple ways to keep cool:

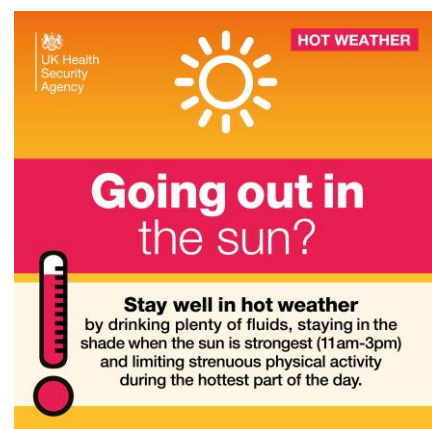
💧 Drink plenty of water throughout the day to stay hydrated.

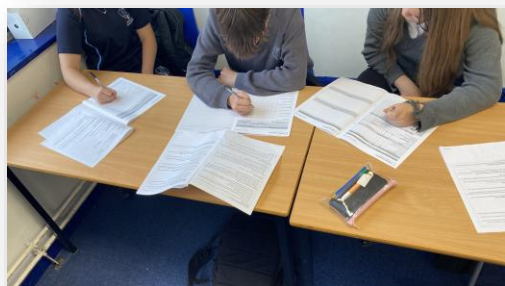
🐾 Team Dog Walk Brings Smiles All Round
